





1) Restricted entry of Automobiles







The NLC has restricted entry of Automobiles, it means:

- i. Only Staff staying far away and in exceptional cases are given permission to bring automobiles.
- ii. All students are restricted to use automobiles. The management does not provide parking space and entry to the students with automobiles. Almost 100% students comply to use the public transport means.
- iii. Only Limited teaching and non- teaching staff are permitted to use vehicles where the vehicle is parked at entrance parking bay. Automobiles are not permitted to enter the campus area to avoid noise pollution, air pollution or Pedestrian path rights.


2) Use of Bicycles/ Battery Powered Vehicles:

- i. In the Campus , the students are allowed to use only bicycles or battery powered vehicles

3) Pedestrian friendly pathways

From entrance (with or without vehicles) each entrance is connected to pedestrian friendly pathways. It is wide, tar road. These are about <u>000</u> foot wide. Trees are along the both sides of pedestrian, pathway geometrically diagonal, straight, not curved, corroded.

It is covered by shadow of trees along the side. These pedestrian pathways are free from the automobiles. It is a well maintained path.









4) Ban on Use of plastic

Plastic bags are a major cause of environmental pollution. It causes untideness in the campus, attracts animals and are the main cause of pollution.

NLC restricts the use of plastic in campus by spreading awareness through flyers and banners which are displayed at various places.

NLC had carried out environmental audit for the promotion of Green campus audit, especially to promote ban on use of plastics.









5) Landscaping with Trees


NLC is placed in huge campus where there is Nalanda ICSE School, Nalanda College etc.

It is a natural beauty, the management has planned and planted these trees since the inception stage and is well maintained.










8) Potted Plant:


3) Pedestrian-Friendly Pathways:
